REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR LEARNER PERMIT AT DPS

PROOF OF IDENTITY - Students must bring documents from one of the following options

DE964 CERTIFICATE - Obtained from the Driving School		
Requirement: Students must complete the first 6 hours of class and pass both parts of the permit test to receive the initial DE-964 Certificate required for a learner permit. After completing the full driver's ed program, they will receive the final certificate needed for a driver license.		
VERIFICATION OF ENROLLMENT - Obtained from High School Attendance Office		
Requirement: This document verifies 90% attendance and good grades. Students taking a homeschool program will need to contact their administrators to receive this document. Ineligibility for a VOE will delay the start of the driving phase.		
SOCIAL SECURITY CARD		
Requirement: Only original cards are accepted; digital copies are not allowed.		
PROOF OF RESIDENCY - Bring 2 Items		
Requirement: The parent/guardian accompanying you to the DPS must have their name and Texas residential address on all presented documents.

• DRIVING PRACTICE - LEARNER PERMIT MUST BE PRESENT FOR EVERY LESSON	
<p style="text-align: center;">Driving with the School</p> Includes 7 hours of driving and 7 hours of observation. Students can schedule up to 2 appointments at a time through their driving school account. Cancellation & Rescheduling Policy: Appointments canceled within 24 hours or missed will incur a \$35 fee. Cancellations are managed through the school account.	<p style="text-align: center;">Driving at Home</p> 30 Hour Log: Students must complete 30 practice hours with a licensed adult, in addition to 14 hours with the school. Students can track 1-hour per day The log is available for download under Rules & Resources.
• ROAD TEST & DRIVER LICENSE	
<p style="text-align: center;">Eligibility Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students must hold the learner permit for 6 months - Be at least 16 years old - Complete classroom, driving hours & 30-hour log - Complete the Impact Texas Teen Drivers Program - Valid 3 months 	<p style="text-align: center;">After Passing the Road Test:</p> Students will receive an envelope with their documents and test results, or they can opt for digital submission for an additional fee. Once submitted to the DPS, either in person or online, teens will receive their Driver License.
